The majestic Cotesworth Culture & Heritage Center in Carrollton will transform into a winter wonderland for “A Christmas Carroll: Trees of Cotesworth” — a stunning celebration featuring 25 uniquely decorated Christmas trees, decor, and festive displays throughout the historic 1840s Greek Revival home. Come celebrate the Season in historic style!

You are invited to be a “Tree Sponsor” for this wonderful event. As a tree sponsor, you will be responsible for providing an artificial 6’ tree, decorating it and then taking them down in early January. Two representatives are invited to be our guests at the opening night on November 14. (Guest tickets are \$15.)

This year’s theme is Celebrating America 250. That doesn’t mean that you must decorate in red, white and, and blue. However, the decorations should honor some part of the patriotic theme. *(For example, the Post Office could include pictures of patriotic themed stamps through the years.)* Last year, the Antiquities Society used pictures of historic homes in Carrollton as ornaments. Just a reminder that if you are interested in being a tree sponsor, the 4th of July decorations sale after the 4th would be a good place for decorations and so would Oriental Trading’s patriotic supplies.

The trees will be viewed by visitors who come for house tours and by people who come to Cotesworth for one of the many workshops and sessions that will be scheduled throughout the event. Information from the attached **Tree Sponsor Form** will be used to create a sign for your tree so people can see your support for this historic home and your name will be listed in our publicity before, during, and after the event. **Also attached is a list of the sessions from 2025.** *(Some will be repeated, others will be new. This just gives you an idea of the sessions that might be held this year.)*

Special Events during A Christmas Carroll: Trees of Cotesworth

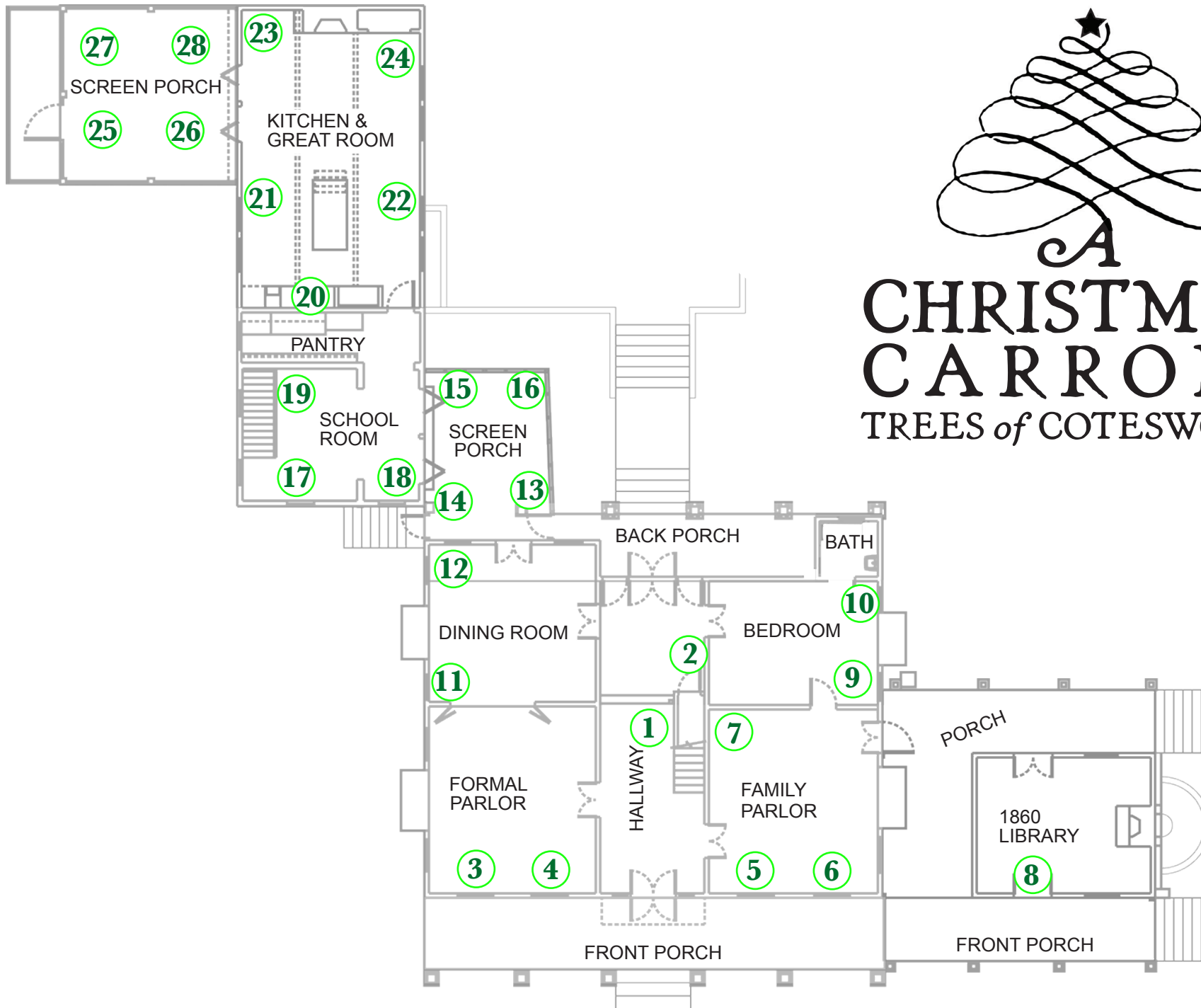

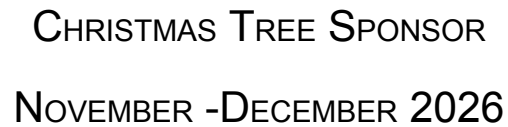
